

IMPLEMENTING OUR MISSION



Chicago-Calumet River System

- Subwatersheds cover roughly 1,000 square miles
- 156 linear miles of waterways
- 75% natural shoreline
- 37,000 acres of open space (within ½ mile)
- Passes through our densest urban areas, suburban communities, rural, and protected natural lands.








The Natural Solutions Tool spans...


- 42 subwatersheds


